# WHO ENFORCES

---



## Judicial Officer

- Setting up of a provisional judicial guarantee on shares, stocks and securities
- Verbal public and Internet forced auction sale of movable/immovable assets and businesses attached
- Distribution of monies collected during forced auction sales to creditors



## Judge


- Evictions
- Arrest of persons according to a court decision
- Handing of children according to a court decision



## Prosecutor



## Lawyer/Solicitor (or equivalent)



## Notary



## Police Authorities

- Overseeing physical bringing of a party to a court hearing

# ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURE

---



## Enforceable title

- Domestic judgement
- Foreign judgement  
(in accordance with applicable international/domestic law)



## Enforcement application to enforcement court by the creditor



## Initiation of enforcement procedure

**Enforcement procedure depending on the nature of the claim (monetary/non-monetary)**

**Measures that can be taken by judicial officer/judge:**

- Attachment of movable/immovable goods in the hands of debtor/third-party
- Attachment in the hands of a third-party of funds owed to the debtor
- Attachment of intangible goods other than funds owed to the debtor
- Freezing and/or collection of tangible movable goods that should be handed over by the debtor
- Attachment of earnings, goods placed in a safe, crops, motor vehicles, ships, vessels, and airplanes
- Arrest of persons according to a court decision etc.

# HOW LONG DOES THE PROCESS LAST

---



**No time limits to conduct enforcement**

**Enforcement can be postponed upon request or suspended ex officio**

**(when assets cannot be located/debtor's address is incorrect)**

# HOW MUCH DOES THE PROCESS COST

---



## Court fees

### Fixed, based on claim's value

- Value up to 50,000 DKK (approx. €6,700):  
500 DKK (approx. €67)
- Value more than 50,000 DKK:  
750 DKK (approx. €100) plus 1.2% of the amount  
exceeding 50,000 DKK  
*Maximum: 75,000 DKK (approx. €10,000)*
- Review of a decision regarding exercise of  
authority:  
2,000 DKK (approx. €270)

## Listing fees, in addition to court fees

- For hearing/written proceedings that might  
replace trial hearing
- For claims exceeding 50,000 DKK
- Amount generally the same as in court fees

## Enforcement fees

- Fixed, proportionally based on a percentage of  
the amount above 3,000 DKK (approx. €400)
- Fee for initiation of enforcement proceedings:  
300 DKK (approx. €40), irrespectively of the  
value of the claim
