### **Non-Monetary Claims**

- → Handing over movable assets
- → Eviction
- → Obligations to act, refrain from acting or suffer action

#### **WHO ENFORCES**



### Private Sector (handling 92% of enforcement)

- → High Court Enforcement Officers
- → Enforcement Agents



#### **Public Sector**

- → County Court Bailiffs (County Court)
- → Civilian Enforcement (Magistrates Court)

- → Domestic judgement
- → Foreign judgement
   (in accordance with applicable international/domestic law)



Receipt by enforcement agent (private/public)



Compliance Letter granting period of voluntary fulfilment to debtor

## Validity period of County Court Judgment:

12 months in general

(Possibility for application for extension)

#### **Magistrate Liability Order:**

No timeframe

(preferably full satisfaction to have taken place within a 12-week period)
