WHO ENFORCES



Enforcement Officer

Issuance of enforcement order

- **Duties:**
- Conduct of enforcement proceedings
- Service of documents
- Holds public office as a liberal profession in his/her own name
- Personally accountable
- Operating via his/her office

HOW LONG DOES THE PROCESS LAST



**Duration varies,
depending on the specific case**

**Average duration of enforcement cases:
2 years**

Enforcement officer's fee (fixed)

(for filing enforcement proposal)

- Fee for the commencement of the proceedings
- Performance fee
- Additional fees for enforcement acts
