WHAT IS ENFORCED





Non-Monetary Claims

- → Handing over movable assets
- → Eviction
- → Obligations to act, refrain from acting or suffer action
- → Division of shared items
- → Rendering work and services

WHO ENFORCES



Judicial Officer





Other essential parties in enforcement procedure

- → Enforcement court
- → Creditor
- → Debtor

Status

- → Public official (exercise of public power)
- → Independence / Impartiality

Role

- → Execution of enforceable titles
- → Monitoring of enforcement until it is completed

ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURE



Enforceable title

→ Enforceable court decision granting a right/establishing an obligation/affecting asset



Creditor's petition for enforcement



Court



Allocation of case to judicial officer



Delivery of court's authorization to judicial officer



Service of Notice of enforcement commencement to creditor and debtor



Commencement of enforcement under methods provided by law

→ Methods: enforcement against wages and other permanent pecuniary income; attachment on the bank account of the debtor; enforcement against movable assets/on immovable property; enforcement against shares; eviction; handing over or destroying movable assets; division of a shared item; rendering work and services etc.



Delivery of Enforcement Order specifying means of enforcement to creditor, debtor and third party (if applicable)

 Means assessed and determined by judicial officer

HOW LONG DOES THE PROCESS LAST



Duration depending on adequacy of debtor's assets to satisfy the claim

Duration limited by law

→ Suspension

Not possible to identify sufficient assets/incomes against which enforcement could be carried out within 5 years (natural persons) / 30 months (legal persons)

→ Termination

Discontinuance of all acts taken within 3 working days

HOW MUCH DOES THE PROCESS COST



Enforcement costs

Judicial officer's costs

- > Remuneration and reimbursement of expenses
- → Flat-rate expenses: **EUR 60** in total
- → Other necessary expenses
- → Remuneration for performed enforcement activity
- → Monetary claims
 20% of amount of recovered claim (if not otherwise provided)
- → Non-monetary claims
 - Enforcement on lien established on immovable property: **EUR 30**
 - Eviction: **EUR 200** for each evicted property (max. EUR 2,000)
 - Handing over movable assets: **EUR 30** for each asset (max. EUR 200)
 - Division of shared item: **EUR 100** for each item
 - Rendering work and services: **10%** of the value (EUR 30 EUR 1,000)

Creditor's costs

→ Fee for petition for enforcement commencement: EUR 16.50
